SUBMISSIONS AND PUBLIC HEARINGS ON THE WESTERN CAPE COMMISSIONER FOR CHILDREN BILL [B 4–2018]

The Western Cape Provincial Parliament's Standing Committee on the Premier and Constitutional Matters will conduct public hearings focusing on the Western Cape Commissioner for Children Bill [B 4–2018] as part of its constitutional responsibilities.

The aim of the Bill is to provide for the appointment of a Commissioner for Children in the province of the Western Cape; and to provide for matters incidental thereto.
